New solar output on Majorca

SolarWorld AG is to build four solar power plants with a total peak output of 8.5 MW on the Mediterranean island of Majorca which are planned to be connected to the grid in early 2008.

In addition to its modules, SolarWorld AG will be deploying its support frame technology for the plants, which are expected to generate some 11.9 GWh annually.

Deutsche Bank AG coordinated the project development and set up the financing of the power plants and SolarWorld has said it intends to realise, together with Deutsche Bank, further projects in the Mediterranean region with Spain, Italy and Greece of particular interest.
